#### WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

We are in Week 4 of 9 in our Ensemble Unit. The students have been assigned a small group, called an ensemble, where they have been leading their own rehearsals. The ensembles will perform in this way, with no conductor, for the Winter Concert.

The skills required to participate in an ensemble encourage a higher level of thinking: students must listen to identify what is wrong, strategize a practice technique to correct the problem, and make a group decision if the strategy worked. I have seen great teamwork developing in each orchestra!
